- * (4) Provides mechanical expertise to other district project managers.
- * (5) Evaluates new HVAC system design, components and control technology and their possible application within school buildings.
- * (6) Responsible for overseeing end to end system testing, programming, starting up, commissioning, and servicing on assigned projects.
- * (7) Reviews equipment submittals for incorporation into design.
 - Manages the district's technical guidelines for new construction, remodel and renovation.
- * (8) Prepare progress reports on new construction, renovations and remodeling projects.
- * (9) Make frequent visits to job sites for first-hand visual inspection and conferencing with contractors and inspectors.
- *(10) Assist with development of long-range capital projects and budget estimates.
